The Software Engineer II (second level of three) designs and develops software applications. He/she performs coding, debugging, testing, and troubleshooting throughout the application development process. The Engineer may mentor junior level Software Engineers. He/she collaborates with other functional groups to conduct software design reviews.

The Software Engineer III develops and/or provides technical leadership in the development of software involving application of new technologies with significant technical risk. They prepare detailed plans, which may span over a year for programs or complex projects. The Engineer determines test philosophy, goals, and objectives. They participates in the formation of project goals, scope, and schedule.

- Designs and develops a processing platform using various configuration management technologies (20%)

- Collaborates cross-functionally with data scientists, business users, and other engineers to achieve solutions (20%)
